

welcome you. You are welcome to use this number to phone in to check on how your child is settling in and rest assure that we would contact you if we felt that there was a concern and your child could not settle without you.

For children attending the School site:-

Please note: Our new and sole entrance is via the Play Park/Church and enter through the small gate at the top of the steps looking down onto the school and Pre-School Room. The small gate will only be unlocked just prior to opening times and then relocked. Parents are requested to use the one- way system of lining up down the slope in family groups following a minimum of 1 meter social distancing. The children will be taken into the room from the small door at the bottom of the slope, leading directly into the room. As a parent if you need to pass on a quick message, we ask that you wait by the shed until all of the children are safely inside the room. Parents will then be asked to leave the premises by walking up the steps and going back out through the gate. Under NO circumstances are any parents allowed to walk through the school premises; that is one of the conditions of the school allowing us to return to this site. If you have another sibling in school, then we are afraid that you will have to walk all of the way around the outside of the school between drop off's and collections. We are aware that for some parents with siblings in school the staggered drop off and collection times with school might clash with our times, please speak to us and we can arrange for you to adapt your timings with us to help support you going between the different school entrances. As with the Town Hall please feel free to phone us on 01626 852147 Ext 3 if you want to check in on how your child is settling in.

As a Pre-School we are doing everything we can to keep your child(ren) as safe as possible, but we also need a commitment from yourselves as parents and carers: -

- No child should be sent into Pre-School if they or any family member are showing any slight signs of covid or being unwell, including high temperatures.
- If your child/ren display any symptoms of Covid-19 you should not send them to school but get them tested. Please follow the government guidelines for isolation for your child and family members until you receive the result of the test. In the event of a positive test of Covid-19, we will follow Public Health England advice. Children with a negative test will be able to return to school immediately. If a child becomes symptomatic of Covid-19 in Pre-School, they will be isolated from their bubble, sent home immediately and asked to have a test.
- Please do not send your child with any unnecessary baggage, no toys please unless it is an important comforter to your child. Can we ask that you provide a plastic bag to put your child's comforter it when not in use.
- No parents are allowed into either of our rooms unless in the case of an emergency or as outlined above. Please follow our social distancing rules on arrival and collection at our sites. Both sites have allocated isolation rooms if a suspected case of Covid-19 arose.
- Government guidance is, that where possible only one family member should come to drop off or collect their child to limit numbers of people in close proximity to one another.
- If you need to speak to a lead practitioner, please stand to one side to allow us to safely get all of the children inside first then we will be able to speak to you.

- Children will be playing outside as much as possible and doors and windows will be open for ventilation. Please send your child in clothes that will not be spoilt outside, sensible footwear and with jumpers or cardy's to wear it case they get chilly.
- Please can you label any items that your child will be bringing into Pre-School- coats, clothing, lunch boxes; we will not have the benefit of parents coming into our buildings to help identify your child's belongings.

We thank you for your cooperation in helping to keep both children and staff as safe as possible during these difficult times.

We want Pre-School to be a safe, happy environment for all of the children and staff working 😊.
