
Chudleigh Pre-School Summer Term 2021



Let's Get Exploring!

That's the title of our current theme! At the moment we are being detectives finding out about 'Under the sea', learning about the sea-bed, oceans and all of the creatures and fish that live within these waters. There is lots of small world water play happening with sea creatures and natural resources including shells, pebbles and drift wood in every container we have! The fish are bobbing in Jelly Biff at the Town Hall this week and everyone is having great fun. We're using our non-fiction books and our Kindle Fires to help find out lots of information and learn exciting new words.

At the School Site one of the children's favourite stories is '**Commotion in The Ocean**, a great rhyming book full of poems about different sea creatures. The children decided to create their own imaginary fish which together created this great display.





Over the next few weeks we might go exploring in submarines, look for mermaids and pirates then explore the beach with its sand and rock pools- who knows where the children's interests might suddenly take us!

Looking ahead

The children at our School Site; who are starting school in September are already having great fun with trial visits into school; all very carefully Covid planned; they are loving the experiences and have all gone in really confidently with our staff there to support them. These visits are a super opportunity for our children to meet the Foundation teachers and explore what will be their new learning environments. Devon County always recommend that a Transition document is written for each child which is given to you as parents but also with your



permission is sent on to school to pass to your child's new teacher. These documents will be sent out the week beginning the 12th July.



We will be contacting you shortly with more information but on the morning of **Monday 19**th **July** those children who are eligible to attend the School Site in September will have an opportunity to come up to that site and have a play session. Any child who is 3 years old by the 31st August 2021 and will be starting school the following September is eligible to attend this site. We will also be sending out information about **Open Sessions** for you as parents to come and have a look around this setting and meet the staff after 3.30pm.

Invoices

You should have now received your invoices. Please pay any outstanding invoices before the end of term. If you have any concerns over the payment, please do not hesitate to come to the office where we can discuss a payment plan.



If your child is entitled to 30 hours funding from September, please make sure you have filled in a funding form, complete with your 30 hour entitlement code and National Insurance Number, and returned it to the office as soon as possible. Codes are needed by end of term (deadline is 31st August – however,

lease remember that Pre-School is closed during

the summer holidays). If you are unsure about whether your child qualifies, you can check your eligibility online.

PARENTS NEED TO CONFIRM THEIR ELIGIBILITY AS SOON AS POSSIBLE AS CODES NEED TO BE VERIFIED BY THE PROVIDER WITH DCC BY 31ST AUGUST FOR THEM TO ACCESS THEIR FUNDING FROM 1ST SEPTEMBER. ANY VERIFIED FROM 1ST SEPTEMBER WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GET THEIR FUNDED TIME UNTIL JANUARY 2022
